Saints of the Week


Commemoration of St Stanislaus Bishop & Martyr 11th April



Born in Poland about 1030, studied in Paris and Liege, became bishop of Cracow in 1071. Stanislaus was a pastoral bishop, concerned with the reform of the clergy and the sanctity of the people; he helped the poor, and made a visitation of the clergy each year. He came into conflict with the king, Boleslav, who had him murdered in 1079.

St Martin I Pope and Martyr 13th April

Born at Todi in Umbria. Martin was elected Pope in 649; he immediately called a Council to condemn the Monothelite heresy, which denied the two natures of Christ. This brought him into conflict with Emperor Constant II, who had him exiled first to Constantinople where he was condemned to death and stripped of his honours, and then to the Crimea, where he died in 656.
