# Saint Francis of Paola

#### St Francis of Paola, Hermit – 2<sup>nd</sup> April

Born 1416, at Paola in Calabria, Francis lived as a hermit. He attracted many followers by his piety and holiness. He founded a congregation of hermits, which became the Order of Minims. He died at Tours in France in 1507.

## St Isidore, bishop & doctor of the Church 4th April

Born in Seville, about 560; appointed Bishop of Seville in 601. Isidore convoked various synods, notably the fourth Council of Toledo in 633, for the good government of the Church in Spain. He wrote a great deal, and was very concerned with the education of young people, founding a school which was much ahead of its time. He died in 636.



#### St Vincent Ferrer, Priest – 5th April

Born at Valencia in Spain, in 1350. Joined the Dominican Order at the age of 17, and taught and preached until he was 40. Then he began to travel extensively, particularly in France, preaching and exhorting people to the faith.
