- **The Church in Battle is open for Private Prayer on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 10am - 11am.** In line with Diocesan regulations we are in need of more stewards. If you can help for one hour for any of the open days, please let Maggie know by e-mail: battle@abdiocese.org.uk
- **Opening our Churches for Mass.** The Bishop's Conference Guidance extends additional safety requirements over and above those relating to opening our Church for Private Prayer. Bishop Richard has indicated that it is helpful to remember that The Sunday Obligation remains dispensed at this time, and that it is also important that clergy do all that is reasonably possible to maintain their health and no priest or deacon is expected to put himself at risk. In his letter to the Church, Vincent Cardinal Nichols had the following to say 'A significant number of churches may remain closed as they are unable to meet the requirements for opening for individual prayer. Fulfilling these requirements is a precondition for any church opening after the 4th July for the celebration of Mass with a congregation. We cannot return immediately to our customary practices.'

- **At the time of writing** there are no Public Masses scheduled in our Deanery. However, if you wish to follow a local live Mass Fr Eamonn Monson from The Parish of the Good Shepherd in Hastings will stream his 10am Mass on You Tube (in the search bar type in Eamonn Monson). Arundel Cathedral streams Mass here [live stream](#). <https://www.churchservices.tv> is also a source of streamed Masses.
- **Food Vouchers** - The Church nationally has received a large donation to assist those having difficulty in affording food. 

Saint of the Week - Saturday 11th July - Saint Benedict, Abbot, Patron of Europe

Born at Norcia in Umbria about 480. He studied in Rome, and then turned his back on the world and lived in solitude in Subiaco. Disciples came to him and he went to Monte Cassino, where he founded a monastery. He wrote his *Rule*, which established the spirituality and way of life of monastic communities ever since. He died in 547.
