- ➤ Proposed amendments to abortion law: Please act now: Four back-bench amendments to abortion law were expected to be considered and decided by MPs on Wednesday. This has been postponed but is expected shortly. If you have not yet done so, please contact your MP and ask him to support NC15 (lowering the time limit) and NC41 (increasing protection for Downs babies) and oppose NC1 and NC40 (effectively permitting abortion to birth and for any reason).
