Born in 1380, near Siena, Bernardine entered the Friars Minor and was ordained. The journeyed throughout Italy, preaching of God's mercy; he encouraged devotion to the holy name of Jesus. He died in 1444.

Bede was born in 673, near the monastery of Wearmouth. He entered the monastery, was ordained, and lived a life of study and contemplation. His holiness was renowned in his lifetime; his pupils and comrades loved him; the works he wrote, particularly the Ecclesiastical History of England, were remarkable in their time and have endured.
