### A Big 'Thank You' from Ros Vinall:

Dear Parishioners, The 7 Pilgrims returned last week after our 115 kilometre walk from Ferrol in North Spain to Santiago De Compostela. We walked the Camono Ingles in 6 days. Tired, but all survived very well, and found it a wonderful experience. I always said I wanted to do it in silence to meditate and take in all the lovely scenery on route. They laughed (if you know me, I'm usually a chatterbox!) but I did it, and enjoyed the silence most of the time. We had quite a lot of rainy and cloudy conditions but some lovely sun too. The first 2 days we followed a large estuary and the sea and even had a wild swim and beach picnic at the end of the second day! It had been raining but the sun came out in the afternoon in time to enjoy that special time with the other 6 wonderful women I walked with.

Arriving in Santiago was very special, tired but exhilarated at what we had achieved and cheered on by the crowds for our final steps. Bagpipes played to us under the arch to the main square, then the fabulous sight of the amazing Cathedral, and lots of happy Pilgrims. They said most days see over 2000 Pilgrims arrive from different routes and from all over the world. We met many Americans, some Australians, Asians and Europeans.

We stayed in a converted monastery that night and finished with the Pilgrims Mass at the Cathedral in the evening. What a journey, and we raised over £10,000 between us for the small Kent charity that supports families who have been victims of Domestic Abuse. So, a big 'Thank You' to everyone who supported me with donations and good wishes. It means a lot to this small charity.

➤ Your help is needed to safeguard 'The Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme (LPWGS)' which allows churches to reclaim VAT on works to listed churches.

The scheme is up for renewal in March 2025, with an extension not yet announced. Our churches will experience a considerable financial impact if the scheme is not renewed. CBCEW have set up an e-campaign so that people can send (pre-written) letters to their local MPs in support of continuing the LPWGS.
