• MASSES RETURN TO THE PARISH WEEKEND 18th/19th JULY

It has been confirmed by Bishop Richard, for the avoidance of doubt, that the obligation to physically attend Mass on Sunday remains suspended at the moment. Nevertheless, it is the intention to recommence Sunday Mass wherever possible, and with this in mind our Dean, Fr Raglan writes: 'Bishop Richard is suggesting that his Episcopal Vicar for Sussex, Fr. Peter Newsam, would come to Battle and Horns Cross in a fortnight, 18/19 July and say the usual Masses on Saturday night and Sunday morning. The proposal would also be that a supply priest continues to say Masses at weekends thereafter whilst Fr. Tony is away.'

Naturally, the practical implications are profound as self-distancing by the 1m+ rule remains essential, so the following rules in line with Diocesan Regulations should be noted and followed scrupulously by us all:

- a. As numbers must be limited, please advise Maggie by e-mail battle@abdiocese.org.uk preferably or by telephone 01424 773125 which Mass you wish to attend Saturday 6pm (Battle), Sunday 9am (Northiam) or 10.45am (Battle), and how many members of your immediate family 'bubble' will be attending with you. This will enable us to allocate appropriate spaces, ensure self-distancing, and have as many parishioners as possible attending. PLEASE NOTE THAT IF YOU DO NOT RECEIVE CONFIRMATION BY 9am ON THURSDAY 17th JULY, then unfortunately it will not have been possible to allocate you a space this week. Please do not just 'turn up' for Mass as without having a pre-booked place, very sadly you will not be admitted.
- b. Face coverings MUST be worn.
- c. A one-way system will operate. Stewards will be on duty to assist and their instructions must be followed.

- d. Hand sanitisers will be available at entrances/exits and must be used.
- e. Holy Communion will be distributed under movement strictly controlled by the stewards and offered only in the hand (the priest will sanitise his hands at the altar immediately prior to distribution).
- f. There can be no singing.
- g. The sign of peace will be by slight bow to one's neighbours.
- Church in Battle Open for Private Prayer. The church is our spiritual home, and parishioners are encouraged to attend if they can Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays from 10am 11am. In line with Diocesan regulations we are in need of more stewards. If you can help for one hour for any of the open days, please let Maggie know by e-mail: battle@abdiocese.org.uk
- If you cannot attend Mass and wish to follow a local live Mass, Fr Eamonn Monson from The Parish of the Good Shepherd in Hastings will stream his 10am Mass on You Tube (in the search bar type in Eamonn Monson). Arundel Cathedral streams Mass here <u>live</u> stream. https://www.churchservices.tv is also a source of streamed Masses.
- Food Vouchers The Church nationally has received a large donation to assist those
